Training programme on Paddy Production Technology and Supply of Inputs to farmers under SCSP

Our KVK has organized a one day training programme to farmers on 'Paddy production technology" under SCSP with the support of Indian Institute of Rice Research (IIRR), Hyderabad at KVK on 19th June 2023.

Farmers were enlightened on resource conservation technologies like direct seeding in rice using drum seeder and seed drill, broadcasting, machine transplanting and their advantages, suitability to different farming situations etc,. Also explained about different production technologies viz. nursery management, land preparation, green manuring and its role in soil health maintenance, soil testing and its benefits, nutrient management, weed management, pest and disease management, natural farming methods, soil and water conservation measures.

During the programme farmers were supplied with RNR15048 paddy seed for conducting demonstrations on 'Integrated Crop Management in paddy' at Katrapalli and Kalathur villages of KVB Puram mandal. Also supplied drum seeders and sprayers to the farmers to utilize the same for direct seeding on community basis.

Later farmers were visited instructional farm and demonstration units at KVK. All KVK scientific and non technical staff and farmers from Katrapalli and Kalathur village of KVB Puram mandal were participated in the programme.


