About 30 women farmers prepared different value added products with Jowar, Ragi, Bajra and Korra (Foxtail millet) as a part of millet recipe contest. A team consists of Sarpanch, MPTC, DPD, ATMA, Community health worker and Sr. Scientist and Head selected top 5 women as millet ambassadors based on taste, composition and colour of the millet products and felicitated with certificate of appreciation.

Sri G.Ratnaprasad, DPD, ATMA said that millets are very nutritious food which contains more fibre content, proteins and minerals. He also said that millets are gluten-free and have a low glycemic index, making them ideal for people with celiac disease or diabetes.

The major problems identified were repeat breeding condition, anoestrum, infertility, mastitis and decreased milk yield in dairy animals. Treatment was done and suggested precautionary and preventive measures accordingly. De-worming and De-ticking were done to all the animals. Senior Scientist and Head, RASS-KVK, SMS, Veterinary and Agricultural Extension, Dr. Sravanthi, VAS, Renigunta, Project staff our host organization, RASS, and farmers were attended the programmes.
