Significant Activities:

RASS-KVK has organized training prorammes in coordination with District Resource Center, Chittoor for Village Agricultural Assistants (VAAs) of Tirupati and Srikalahasthi Agricultural Sub divisional RBKs (Raithu Bharosa Kendra's) on "Integrated pest management and Integrated Weed Management practices in major crops in District" on 6th and 7th of January, 2021. Presentations were given on integrated pest management practices, major pest and diseases on major crops and their control measures, importance of weed management in major crops in the district, characteristics of various herbicides, integrated weed management practices, calculation of herbicide dosage, precautions to be taken while spraying of herbicides and herbicides to be used in different crops grown in the respective divisions. Literature on "Importance of soil health management", "Management practices in Mango, Paddy and Tomato" were supplied to the participants. About 120 number off VAAs were participated in the programme.

RASS KVK has organized 'International Womens Day' at Gaddamvaripalli village of Yerravaripalem Mandal on 08.03.2021 with the theme 'Women in leadership: Achieving an equal future in a COVID-19 world. Women farmers were enlightened on women empowerment and gender sensitization, importance of Nutri gardens and its raising, drudgery reduction technologies for farm women in agricultural operations and value addition of fruits and millets, importance of different medicinal plants and their uses in daily life especially for women. KVK women farmers were honored with 'Certificate of Appreciation' for their successful farming practices in agriculture and allied sectors. Village Sarpanch, ICDS Officer and 76 women farmers were participated in the programme.







RASS KVK has organized 'World water day-2021' and 'Awareness programme on National Agro Forestry Scheme' on 22.03.2021 at NICRA viilage, Chittecherla, Chinnagottigallu Mandal. Farmers were explained about farm pond technology and its uses, in situ moisture conservation techniques to improve ground water through percolation of rain water, rain water harvesting techniques and organic farming, polythene mulching, micro irrigation, recharging bore wells, soil health management etc. Resource persons also explained them about present scenario of agro forestry and importance of forests and reforestation, cultivation of different agro forestry plants, carbon sequestration and techniques for improving organic matter in soils. Dr.B.Ravindranath Reddy, Associate Dean and Dr. Hemalatha, Professor, Agronomy, SV Agricultural College, Tirupati, Sri Sanjeeva Reddy, Mandal Agricultural Officer, Chinnagottigallu, Village Sarpanches of Chittecherla and Deendaarlapalli Panchayaths, 9 Village Agricultural Assistants and 109 farmers were participated in the programme. Later farmers were facilitated with CoFS-31 fodder seed for conducting demonstrations.

RASS - KVK has conducted One Day Training Programme for Farmers on "Water and Energy Conservation & Energy Efficiency in Agriculture Sector" at KVK campus on 26th February 2021. Presentations were given by the resource persons and explained about latest farm machinery equipment and their utilization for energy and water conservation by using micro irrigation techniques, benefits of conservation furrows and trench cum bunds formation for efficient utilization of ground water for agriculture and allied activities, importance of natural energy resources, conventional energy and management, importance of solar energy in future and agriculture sector, different schemes for availing solar energy for farming community as well as general usage. Also he briefed about selection and installation of agriculture pump sets, selection of submersible pumps. Subsidy guidelines under APMIP for Supply of drip and sprinkler, fertigation, repair and maintenance of micro irrigation equipment were also briefed to farmers.

Field diagnostic visits:

In coordination with District Resource Cetre, Chittoor KVK has conducted field diagnostic visits on 23 February and 06, 12 and 23 March 2021 to Chinnagottigallu, Nindra, Pichatur, Satyavedu, Vadamalapet, Puttur, Narayanavanam and Thottambedu mandals, observed leaf miner in tomato, tikka leaf spot an Spodoptera in groundnut, stem borer in paddy, Spodoptera in sunflower, sooty mould in Guva and Mango, root and fruit rot in chilli and suggested suitable control measure to respective farmers.
