Narendra Modi's birthday. Sri Thomar said that now a day's everyone is cautious about their health and getting awareness about health and nutrition and importance of millets in daily diet. Hence KVK scientists and other agriculture scientists should focus on to conduct more awareness programmes on millet farming.



Dr. S. Sreenivasulu, Sr Scientist and Head, RASS - KVK, spoke about the main objectives of the program and said that malnutrition is more prevalent among women, young children and pregnant women and this type of programs would help in creating awareness on it. In his speech, he briefed about the main activities of the KVK, importance of Kitchen gardens, bio fortified crops and its importance and value added products etc.

Dr. M. Aruna, Professor, Department of Home Science, SPMVV, Tirupati and Smt. Sudharani, CDPO, Tirupati explained about different types of millets and their nutritional values. She also explained about nutritional requirement of adolescent girls and women based on their age, reasons for malnutrition and precautions to overcome malnutrition in adolescent girls and women. She also briefed about Dr. Y.S.R. Sampoorna poshana kit supplying through Anganwaadi centers.



Dr. Srilatha, SMS, Home Science, Sri P.S. Sudhakar, SMS, Horticulture, Dr.V. Divya, SMS, Crop Production explained about value addition with millets, kitchen garden models and maintenance, terrace gardening and agro forestry for getting additional income

and also to protect environment, bio fortified crops and varieties in rice, Bajra, maize, sorghum and finger millet.

On this occasion, various "vegetable seed kits" required for kitchen garden were distributed to the participants with the help of Indian Fertilizer and Farmer Cooperative Society (IFFCO).
