**National level campaign on
“Efficient and balanced use of fertilizers in agriculture, International Yoga Day -2022 and

RASS - Krishi Vigyan Kendra, Karakambadi has organized National level campaign on “efficient and balanced use of fertilizers in agriculture, International Yoga Day -2022 and Awareness programme on Region Specific Agro forestry” at Vedurukuppam mandal on 21.06.2022 as a part of series of events organizing under Azadi Ka Amrith Mahotsav. Sri Sudhakar Rao, MPDO, Vedurukuppam was the chief guest of the programme.

Dr. S. Sreenivasulu, Senior Scientist and Head, RASS – KVK has explained about the Activities of KVK towards farming community, importance of Soil Testing, utilization of soil health cards for soil health management. He also briefed about the organic farming and its role in production of quality and healthy food for human consumption, role of yoga in healthy and happy life.

Sri Sudhakar Rao, Mandal Parishad Development Officer explained about the Wealth from waste and Brindavanam schemes which are mainly focusing the production of Vermicompost at village level with the farm waste available within the villages. He also spoke about NADEP method of compost preparation and support of Government towards establishment of NADEP Vermicompost units.
